

Cycling Three top problems

- The road has a steep slope and is rough
- There is no non-motorized vehicle lane. The road is narrow and prone to traffic jams
- Bicycle parking spots are not widespread throughout the city

Techniques



More Specific:

We found that in Winchester there are a lot of sloping roads, which are very tiring to even walk on and very difficult to cycle on. And we found that there are a lot of roads that are not flat, they are roads made of gravel, we interviewed passers-by who were cycling, and they said that such roads are very difficult to cycle on and he usually pushes his bike.

We found that the roads here are very narrow, some roads can only pass one car, there is not even a special non-motorized lane, bicycles and cars share a lane, resulting in some cyclists following cars waiting for traffic lights, as in this picture, the big lorry in front of the cyclist blocked the line of sight, which can cause a blind spot and is very dangerous. And we saw an old grandpa cycling very slowly on a very narrow road, but a car behind him had to follow the speed of the old grandpa's bike, which could easily cause a traffic jam.

We did find a lot of bike parking in the city, but it is concentrated in the city centre, so if you need to go to some of the street shops, there is still no place to park your bike if you go there. There are also no places to park like schools. We searched for parking spots on the map, and the map even showed only one spot. And there are some spots where you can just take away the frame where you park your bike and it will be stolen.
