Temporary baby care designed for Generation Z youth


In today's society, young people are increasingly not wanting to have children.

I designed a design project that can temporarily help young parents take care of infants and toddlers to solve the parenting problems of young people.



Generation Z is a generation born between 1997 and 2009


Gen Z has a huge population










### Interview

#### Interviewee A: 21 male who wishes to have children

For the idea of raising a child?

A: I feel that childbearing is an important part of my life and will make my life complete.

Factors to consider when to have children?

A: Try to be early, the body recovery is slow, and I wil also consider the financial and family situation. Also consider whether the work is busy or not

How do you think you should raise your children?

A: I want to provide as good conditions as possible and participate in the growth of my children.

Think about the time it takes to raise a child?

A: 60% to 70%

#### Interviewee B: 20 female who is unsure whether she will have children

Whether you think that the joy of raising children can replace the joy of personal time?

B: No, playing with family is no substitute for playing with friends.

For the idea of raising a child?

B: I think fertility is a devotion. But I don't want to allocate personal time to my children, I haven't played enough. Think about the time it takes to raise a child?

B: About 50%, but maybe only 30%, trying to separate your time from raising children as much as possible Maybe something made you decide to have a baby?

B: If there is extra money and time, and the partner is responsible

#### Interviewee C: 29 female who has a 4-year-old son

Whether you think that the joy of raising children can replace the joy of personal time?

C: Playing with children is tiring, and it can't replace my own play time.

Do you feel nostalgic for the days before you gave birth after having a baby?

C: Of course, there is too little time to play at all. Sometimes when I want to go out on weekends, I can't find someone to help take my child, because my parents don't live with me and can't help me with my children.

Think about the time it takes to raise a child?

C: 80%, basically no complete personal time

- Strong need for personal time.
- Raising children is more time-consuming than think.
- Sometimes there is no one to help with the children









The child is handed Wait for the babysitter to find the child in the over to babysitter, who conducts a waiting area, where ustomer can chat with health check. other parents




