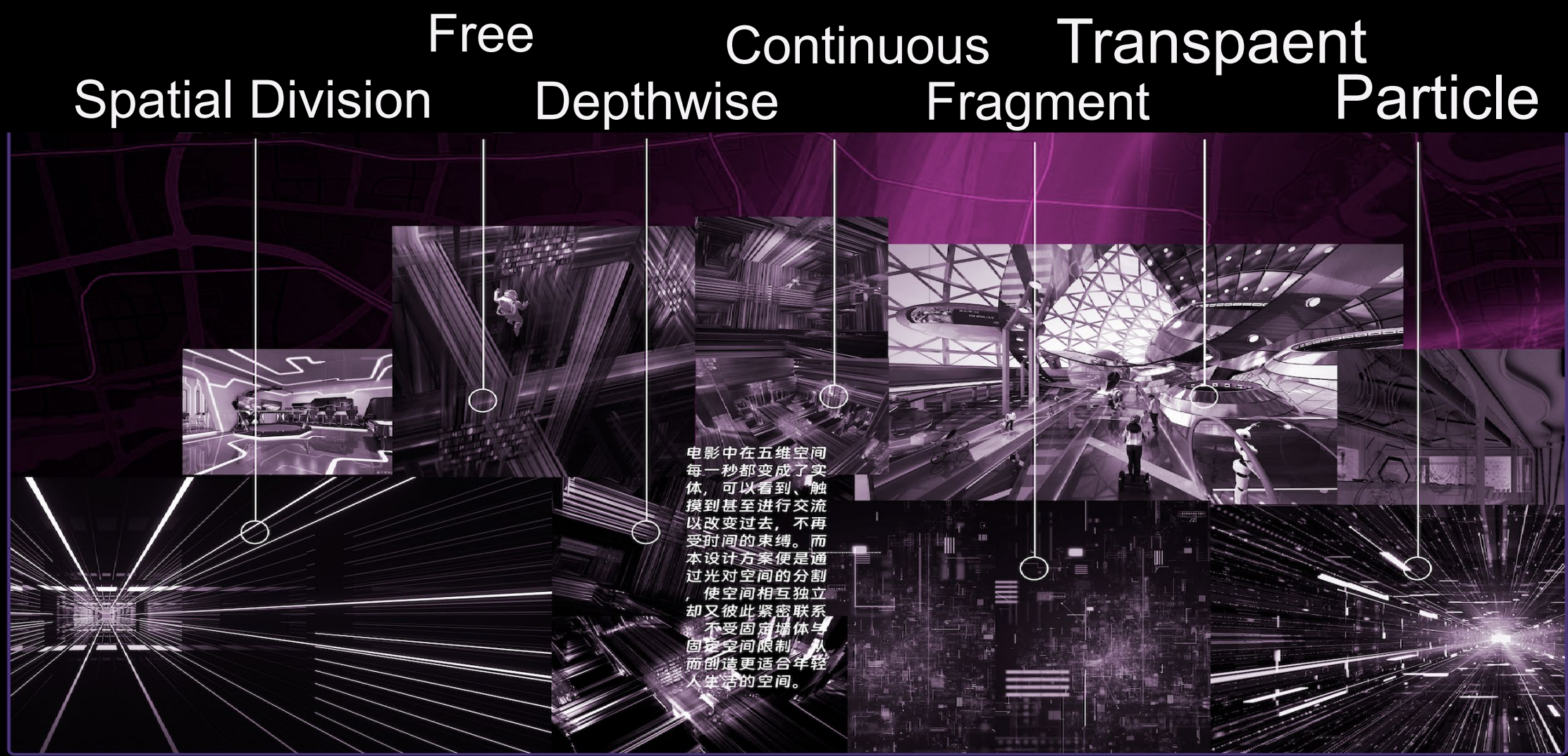

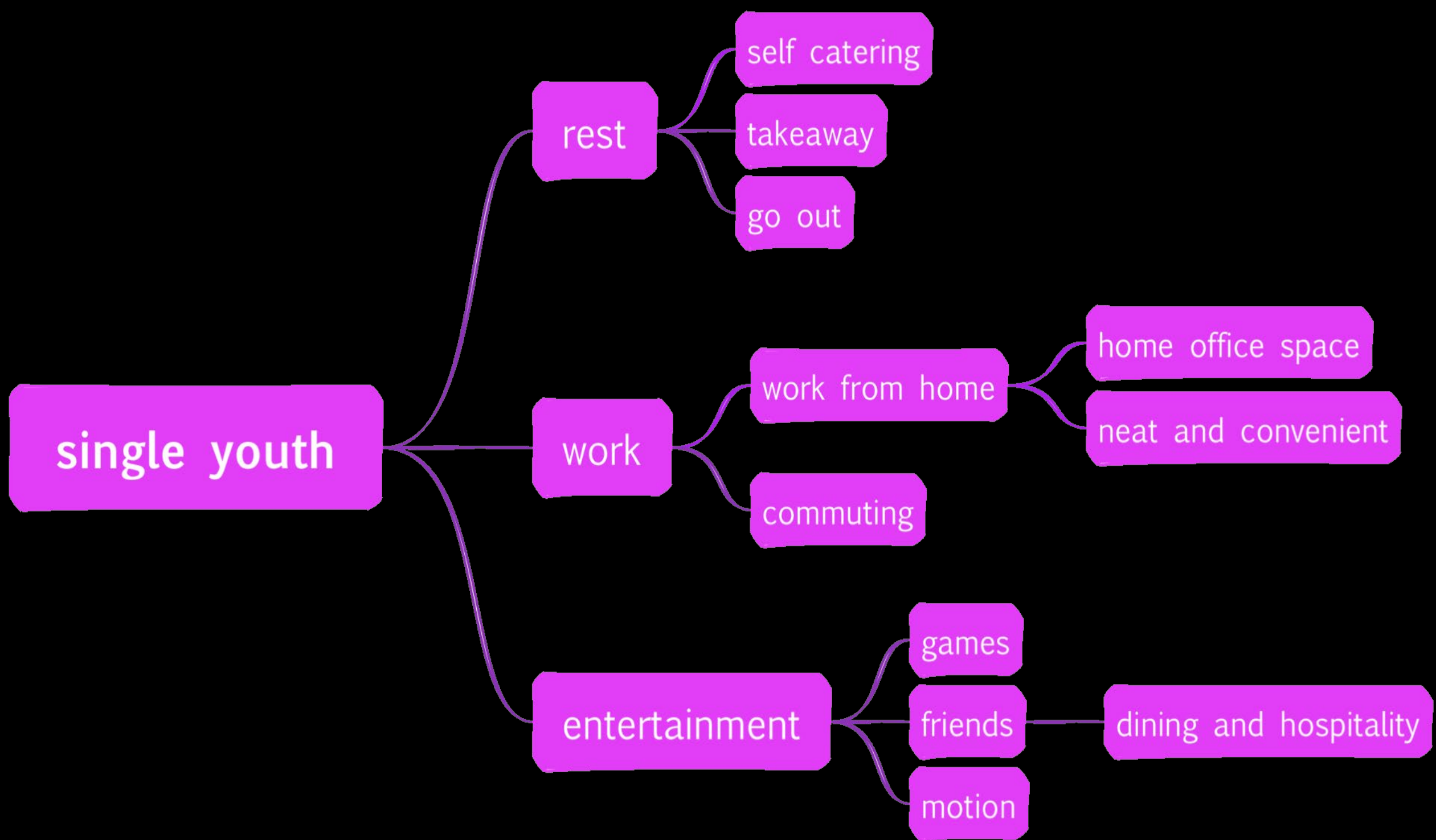

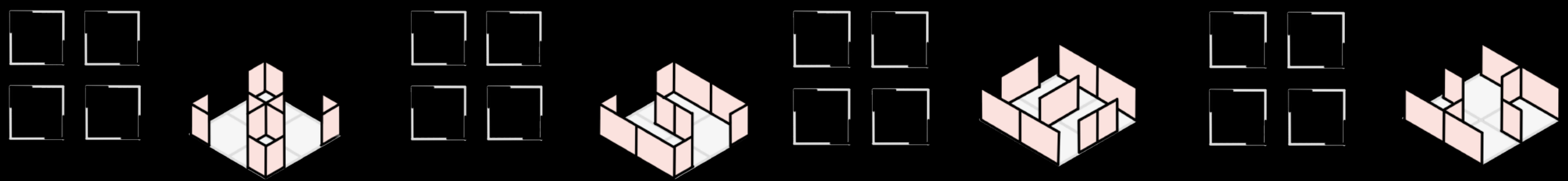


ANALYSIS OF YOUNG ADULTS LIVING ALONE

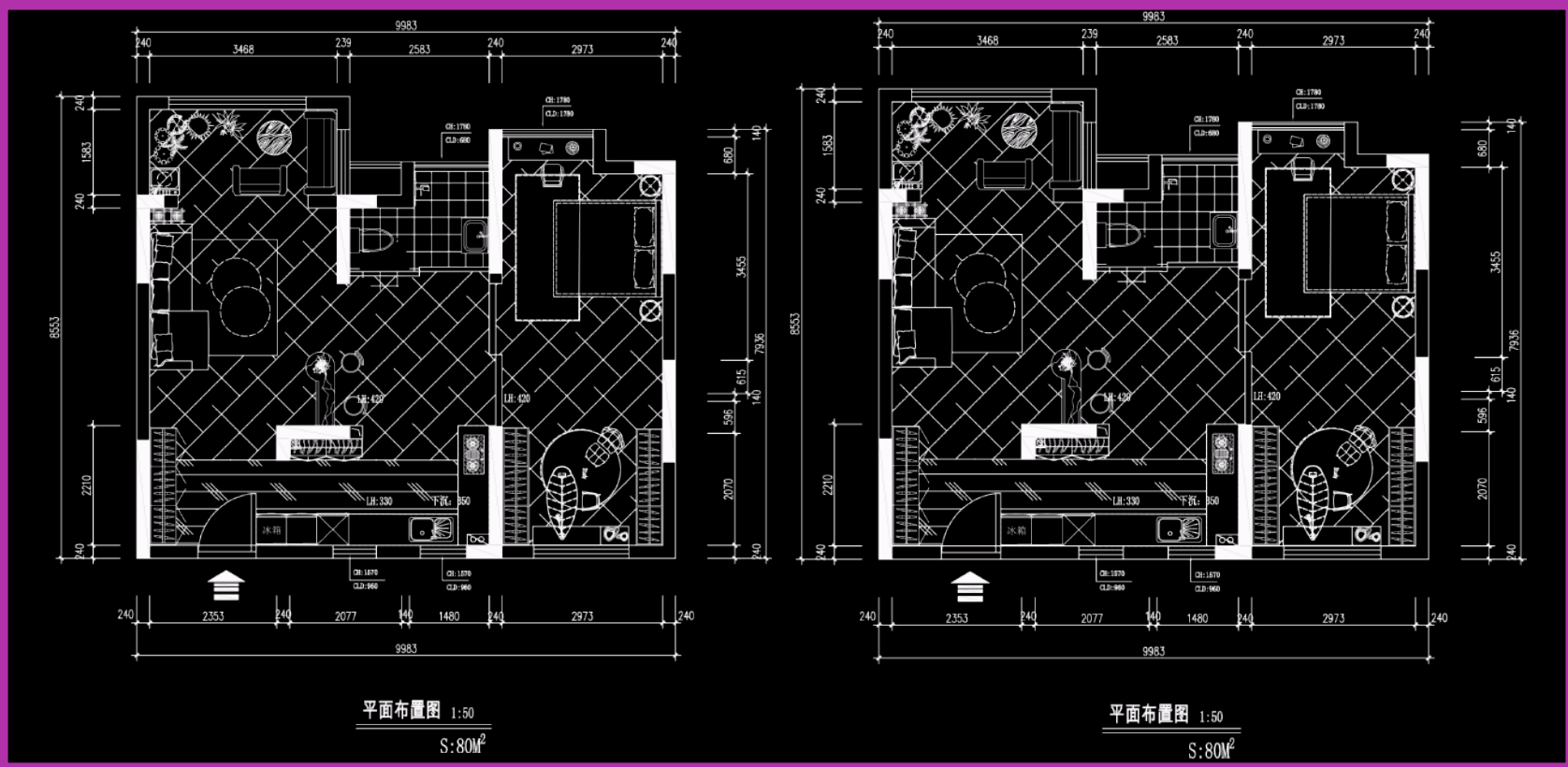
