



Where's the cafe?

Some people choose to come to the cafe to finish their homework.





This is because their assignments are more craft-oriented and do not lend themselves to the library.




Some people choose to come to the cafe to learn.






Distribution of users of the Café








01 conclusion

Analysis of traffic flow






Chatting was at its highest at three o'clock, with the same number at four and five o'clock.

Recommendations and reflections
