Framework planning for the DIEP report

It is important to note that you are reflecting on your personal practice and performance and NOT on what you have learned about your subject over the course of semester one.

DIEP stands for **Describe**, **Interpret**, **Evaluate**, **Plan**. Each of these are stages of reflection that build towards true reflection in evaluating your current or recent practice and planning future practice.

Planning for the final report

The report will consist of a DIEP analysis of each project.

Describe - Describe the background, user group and purpose of my project.
50 words

Interpret - Explain the reason and significance of my project. 50 words

Evaluate - Reflect on the design process and results of my project (strengths, weaknesses, more diverse ideas) 200 words

Plan - Thoughts and expectations for my future projects based on the experience of this project. 200 words

What areas of my practice would I like to develop further?

What could I have done differently?

What should I try to build into my practice for forthcoming project?
